

Summerponcho “Ocean breeze”

Sizes: S/M, L/XL

Yarn: Pingo doceur 4, size S/M 6 balls, stl L/XL 7 balls

In this pattern I use the colour ciel.

Crochet hook 4,5mm for the poncho, crochet hook 3mm to the edging around the neckline.



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Poncho:

16 shells on the width in both sizes.

With crochet hook 4,5mm ch 86

1. 1 dc in the 8th ch from the hook, ch 3, 1dc in the same ch as the last dc, ch1, skip 4 ch, in the next ch *(1dc, ch3, 1dc, ch1), skip 4ch*, repeat ** and end the row with a dc in the third ch.


2. Ch3, *7dc in the ch3-space*, repeat ** and end the row with a dc in the third ch.

3. Ch 4, *in the 4th dc work (1dc, ch3, 1dc, ch1)*, repeat ** and end the row with a dc in the third ch.

4. Ch3, *7dc in the ch3-space*, repeat ** and end the row with a dc in the third ch.


Repeat rows 3 and 4 until the work measures (S/M) 118cm, or 44 shells, (L/XL) 129cm, or 48 shells.

Fold and sew the poncho as the picture shows. Measure so you sew 47 cm in.

Neckline:

1. Crochet 1 row sc around the neckline. Start in the back, 3sc in every other ch-space, which is a bit larger than the other, and 2dc in every other ch-space. In the last ch-space before the seam in the front, crochet 1sc, 3 sc together (1 in the last ch-space, 1 in the seam and 1 in the next ch-space), 1sc in the first ch-space after the seam, and then continue with 3 in every other and 2 in every other as before. End with a sl st.
2. Ch 1, 1 sc in each sc, in the front you crochet 3sc together.
3. Edging: Change to a 3mm crochet hook. Ch1, *1sc, ch3, 1dc in the third ch from the hook, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc in the next stitch*, repeat ** and end with a sl st.

Edge:

1. Start in the back, 3dc in every other ch-space and 2dc in every other ch-space as before. After the front seam you start crocheting sc instead. *Skip 1dc, 1sc in the following 5 dc:s, skip 1 dc*, repeat ** until the last ch-space on this side. In the chainspace you work 2dc, ch3, 2dc, and start crocheting dc:s again. As before, you make 3 dc in every other ch-space and 2 dc in every other, end with a sl st.
2. 1dc in every dc, in the ch3-space you make 2dc, ch3, 2dc.
3. 1dc in every dc, in the ch3-space you make 2dc, ch3, 2dc.
4. 1 sc in every dc, in the ch3-space you make 4sc.

Fringes:

Cut pieces of yarn, approximately 26cm. Put 2 pieces in every other stitch around the poncho and tie a knot. Cut the yarn ends so they all are the same length.
